

SANIX CUP U-17 INTERNATIONAL HANDBALL TOURNAMENT 2017 MEN'S FORMAT

1. Pool stage (25min. - 10 min. - 25min.)

The twelve competing teams will be grouped into three pools of four teams to play against each other in a round-robin competition.

The teams are ranked according to the following criteria:

- 1) Match points are awarded as follows: Win - 2 points, Draw - 1 point, Loss - 0 point
- 2) Winner between the teams concerned.
- 3) Difference between goal points scored for and goal points scored against between the teams concerned.
- 4) Goal points in the matches between the teams concerned.
- 5) Difference between goal points scored for and goal points scored against by each top 3 team.
- 6) Goal points in the matches by each top 3 team.
- 7) Difference between goal points scored for and goal points scored against in its all pool matches.
- 8) Goal points in the matches in its all pool matches.
- 9) Drawing of lots

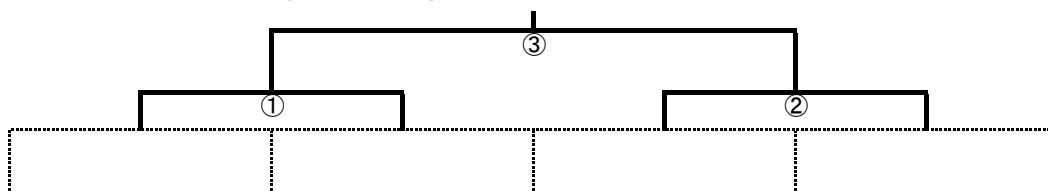
2. Final tournament / Friendly match (30min. - 10 min. - 30min.)

To determine the pairings for the final tournament and the friendly matches, ranking of the teams in each same ranked teams' group will be based on:

- i. Match points;
- ii. Difference between goal points scored for and goal points scored against by each top 2 team of each pool;
- iii. Difference between goal points scored for and goal points scored against by each top 3 team of each pool;
- iv. Goal points scored by each top 3 team of each pool;
- v. Drawing of lots;

● Final tournament

The final tournament will be competed among the first placed teams of each pool and the first placed team of the second ranked teams' group, totalling four teams.



*The pairings will be determined by drawing of lots so that two teams in the same pool will not play against each other at the first round.

● Friendly match

- ④ 2nd in the rank 2 group vs 3rd in the rank 2 group
- ⑤ 1st in the rank 3 group vs 2nd in the rank 3 group
- ⑥ 3rd in the rank 3 group vs 1st in the rank 4 group
- ⑦ 2nd in the rank 4 group vs 3rd in the rank 4 group

*1st and 2nd in the rank 4 group will be replaced if both teams playing at 'Friendly match ⑥' belonged to same pool at the pool stage.

*If the game is tied at the final tournament and the friendly matches, 7MTC will be carried out.

For the final only, a first overtime period is played then if the game is again tied, the winner will be determined by 7MTC.

3. Official ball

4. The number of registered players

16 players or less can be registered at each game.

5. Miscellaneous

- Change of players can be allowed until the coaches' meeting on Friday, October 13.
- All coaches are required to bring their team's first and second uniform (CP's and GK's as well) to the coaches' meeting.
- Cohesive tapes are allowed to use but resin (including spray resin) is prohibited.
- Shoes and balls which are only for indoor use and not stained with resin can be used in the gymnasiums.
